


Collisionville is releasing a new single, "Heart That Just Won't Break," on Friday, October 7, 2022. It's a tale of resilience and defiance told with drums, bass, and two kinds of guitars, with twangy exhaust spewing out of the punk rock engine. It was recorded at Tiny Telephone Studios in San Francisco (just before the SF location closed!) in February of 2020, and then...

To begin with, it'll only be available as a 7-inch vinyl record or as a digital download from Collisionville's Bandcamp site.(It will land on other streaming services by early 2023.) The record is a nice and hefty 70 grams, very stout for a 7". It's a split single with fellow Oaklanders REQ'D from Wondertaker Records.
